

What is Communication's Lesson Plan (Chapter 1, Module 2, Lesson 2)		
Duration	Objective	Activity
5 mins	1. Foster a sense of community where all know each other and feel comfortable in each other's presence 2. Establish guidelines for respectful and effective communication and collaboration within the group.	Introduce yourself and have students introduce themselves if they do not know eac other. Start with a list of rules and have students add (large group activity).
10 mins	1. Recall important communication skills 2. Explain different forms of communication 3. List the ways in which a communication can be improved	 Questions and discussion: Ask the preassessment questions. If youth cannot provid the answers, fill the gaps with a lecture/video. Pre-assessment questions: Why is it important to listen when someon is speaking? How can we express our ideas clearly when talking to others? What does it mean to be respectful when communicating with someone? How can we use words and actions to show kindness when talking to others?
10 mins	Explain the importance of effective communication and practice skills for clear and respectful communication	Small group discussion about communication
5 mins	Reflect on the impact of commincation on real life	Large group discussion about communication
5 mins	Each student is able to state at least one thing they will take away from the lesson	Ask students " what is one thing you learned today? How will you use what you learned? As everyone to name one thing. Show a video highlighting key concepts.
