Duration	Objective	Activity
5 mins	1. Foster a sense of community where all know each other and feel comfortable in each other's presence 2. Establish guidelines for respectful and effective communication and collaboration within the group.	Introduce yourself and have students introduce themselves if they do not know each other. Start with a list of rules and have students add (large group activity).
10 mins	Explain the possible dangers of online dating for underage children	<ul> <li>Questions and discussion: Ask the preassessment questions. If youth cannot provide the answers, fill the gaps with a lecture/video. Pre-assessment questions:</li> <li>What is one danger of meeting someone in person whom you've only met online?</li> <li>Why is it important to keep personal information private when using the internet?</li> <li>Why is it important to verify the identity of people you meet online?</li> <li>What are some signs that someone may no be who they say they are online?</li> <li>Why is it important to talk to a trusted adult about your online activities and interactions?</li> </ul>
10 mins	Discuss the possible dangers of online dating for underage children	Large group discussion about online dating
5 mins	Each student is able to state at least one thing they will take away from the lesson	Ask students "What is one thing you learned today? How will you use what you learned? As everyone to name one thing. Show a video highlighting key concepts.
